

# Author's Guide for Winter School

---

## Format

- Use the CUP LaTeX2e template
- Maximum length of chapter: 50 pages (including references)
- Provide an abstract

## Orthography and Style

- Use British spelling
- Single inverted commas for quotations
- Double inverted commas for quotations within quotations
- Extended quotations to be broken off from the main text, using 9pt font and no inverted commas
- All mathematical variables within math mode

## References

- Use author/date system for references (natbib)
- For multiple author works:
  - In the text list up to three authors for first citation and then 1st author et al. thereafter
  - In the bibliography list up to eight authors in full
  - For nine or more authors list the 1st author followed by et al.
- Example references:
